IDEA Early Learning Centre (ELC) is owned by IDEA Education and will serve the Victory Heights community of Dubai.

To create a world-class learning environment, SBS Education supported the pre-operations project to open the inspiring ELC for its September intake.

Vision & curriculum

The ELC will follow the highly regarded Creative Curriculum from the US and is licensed in Dubai to operate from ages 1 to 6 with a total capacity of 240 children.

As the field of early childhood education has evolved, so too has the curriculum, incorporating the latest research and best practices and taking the needs of every type of learner into account. The curriculum helps to create a learning environment that enables each child to become a creative, confident thinker.

IDEA prepares children for the more formal curriculum and aligned with the English National Curriculum and the American Core Standards.

Children develop quickly in the early years and their experiences between birth and age six has a major impact on their future life chances. We aimed to create an attractive, welcoming and stimulating learning environment that encourages children to explore, investigate and learn through first-hand experience. Activities are planned for both inside and outside learning, including water, sand, creative workshops, ICT, numeracy activities, drawing, with a strong programme for literacy, writing and reading, including languages.

How SBS delivered the project

Our project has been led by our Group CEO, Tina Brown and the team have delivered different phases of support (see left). It is essential that planning for a new school or nursery start up is comprehensive and thorough. In order for SBS to achieve this, we applied an analytical framework involving areas for action (see left), which ensured that each aspect of pre-operational requirement was addressed.

This approach enabled the pace of planning to be kept up, while providing a comprehensive check list for coordinated action. We set KPIs at each section of development with clear milestones.




Future of partnership
